OUTDOOR WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

All residents/landowners must sign up for the RRID Alerts! Go to our webpage and press the tab for "Sign up for Alerts" and follow the instructions. Those who do not own a cell phone or computer must arrange with a family member, friend or neighbour to sign up and give you up-dates. The Alert will be posted on the office sign as well. Automatic sprinkling systems are restricted to a maximum flow of 4 gallons per minute per zone and only one zone can be in use at a time. Open hoses are not permitted; all hoses must have spring loaded shut-off nozzles attached. Filling water troughs for chickens/horses/livestock is exempt from these restrictions, absolutely no unattended running hoses permitted.

No outdoor water use from 9 am – 7pm, 10 pm – 6 am and the 31st of the month.

STAGE ONE ALERT – Mandatory from May 15th to September 30th of each year.

- **odd** numbered addresses: all outdoor water use on odd numbered days only from 6 am - 9 am and 7 pm - 10 pm.
- **even** numbered addresses: all outdoor water use on even numbered days only from 6 am – 9 am and 7 pm – 10 pm.
- one sprinkler for the first acre or portion thereof.
- an additional sprinkler for each additional acre as per the RRID assessment for a maximum of three sprinklers on at one time.

STAGE TWO ALERT

- **lawn sprinkling prohibited. Absolutely no lawn sprinkling allowed.**
- watering of gardens (vegetable & flower) only, **no other outdoor water use permitted.**
- watering of gardens allowed by sprinkler from 6 am – 9 am on your day only.
- one sprinkler per property only.

STAGE THREE ALERT

- **Watering of vegetable and flower gardens by hand with a hose with nozzle attached only.**
- No other outdoor water use permitted.
- Hand watering of gardens allowed from 6 am – 9 am on your day only.

STAGE FOUR ALERT

- **Absolutely no outdoor water use permitted.**

The District will be policing to ensure all residents adhere to these restrictions. No warnings will be given, failure to adhere to these restrictions will result in the limiting of the supply of water and/or the install of a water meter at the landowner's expense. Fines upon summary conviction of up to \$2,000.
