Robson-Raspberry Improvement District

Bylaw No. 109

A bylaw for imposing a charge upon lands subject to tax sale in order to recover the expense incurred by the Robson-Raspberry Improvement District related to the tax sale.

The Trustees of the Robson-Raspberry Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. There is hereby fixed and made payable to the improvement district against each parcel of land proposed to be sold at tax sale, a charge not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$ 5,000). This charge is to cover all actual costs incurred including, but not limited to administration, postage, advertising and facility rental.
- 2. The aforementioned charge shall form part of the upset price of the parcel being sold at tax sale, pursuant to Section 719 of the *Local Government Act*.
- 3. This bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 58.
- 4. This bylaw is cited as the "Taxation Sale Charge Bylaw".
