

ROBSON-RASPBERRY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 111

A bylaw for fixing tolls and other charges payable to the District and the terms of payment thereof and providing for a percentage addition to encourage prompt payment thereof.

The Trustees of Robson-Raspberry Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Unmetered Water Rates

- a) In respect to each single family dwelling an annual toll of \$ 515.
- b) In respect of each single family dwelling utilized as a multiple dwelling, boarding house, etc., an annual toll of \$ 775.
- c) In respect of each additional dwelling, cabin, mobile home, recreational dwelling, tiny home or other accommodation on the same parcel of land utilizing one connection, using water from the District's works,
 - a semi-annual toll of \$ 260.
 - or an annual toll of \$ 515.
- d) In respect of each duplex, suites or apartment buildings, an annual toll per unit of \$ 515.
- e) In respect to service stations and convenience stores an annual toll of \$ 1550.
- g) In respect to neighborhood pubs an annual toll of \$ 3095.
- h) In respect to restaurants an annual toll of \$ 1550.
- i) In respect to schools an annual toll of \$ 3310.
- j) In respect to Robson Fire Department an annual toll of \$ 3505.
- k) In respect to the Pass Creek Riding Stables an annual toll of \$ 750.

2. The aforesaid tolls shall be due and payable on the 31st day of May 2023, and shall have a percentage addition of 10% applied if full payment of aforesaid tolls are not received on or before the 31st day of May each year.


3. The Trustees may by resolution order the water shut off to any premises on which there are any tolls or other charges owing for 60 days or longer. Water shut off under this section shall be subject to the charges levied under Section 5 of this bylaw.
4. The Trustees may by resolution reduce any toll fixed in the preceding clauses in respect of any premises not occupied throughout any period by an amount commensurate with the period the premises are unoccupied, provided the owner or occupant notifies the trustees as to the time the premises becomes or are to become unoccupied and the water supply is shut off for the period when the premises are not occupied, subject to the charges levied under Section 5 of this bylaw.
5. In addition to the aforementioned charges there is fixed and made payable to the district by every owner or occupier of premises in respect to which a request is made, that the water be turned on after having been shut off either by owner or occupier's request, or by order of the trustees, a charge of \$ 50.00 for each time the water is turned off and a charge of \$50.00 each time the water is turned on.
6. This bylaw repeals Bylaw No.102.
7. This bylaw may be cited as the "2023 Tolls Bylaw".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 14th day of September, 2022.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 12th day of October, 2022.
